2	Bower Wattle <i>Acacia cognata 'Limelight'</i>	—	1 m H × 1.5 m W	Full Sun, Part Shade	Low Water
3	Geraldton Wax 'Purple Pride' <i>Chamelaucium uncinatum</i> 'Purple Pride'	—	2 m H × 2 m W	Full Sun	Drought- Tolerant
4	Lemon Myrtle <i>Backhousia citriodora</i>	—	5 m H × 3 m W	Full Sun, Part Shade	Moderate Water
5	Lemon-scented Tea Tree <i>Leptospermum petersonii</i>	—	5 m H × 3 m W	Full Sun, Part Shade	Low Water
6	Long-leaf Wax Flower <i>Philotheca myoporoides</i>	—	2 m H × 1.5 m W	Part Shade, Full Sun	Low Water
7	Oval-leaf Mint Bush <i>Prostanthera ovalifolia</i>	—	3 m H × 2 m W	Part Shade, Full Sun	Moderate Water
8	Rice Flower <i>Ozothamnus diosmifolius</i>	—	2 m H × 1.5 m W	Full Sun, Part Shade	Low Water
9	Tick Bush <i>Kunzea ambigua</i>	—	3 m H × 3 m W	Full Sun, Part Shade	Low Water

How to use this plan

1. Mark out your bed and set plants out (still in pots) using the spacing column.
2. Place taller and wider plants to the back or centre, lower plants to the front or edges.
3. Group by light and water needs so each plant gets the right conditions.
4. Plant, mulch, water in well — then tick each plant off as you go.
